The COPS System Interest Inventory, Professional Level (COPS-P) is a form of the widely used COPS Interest Inventory designed for use with college and adult examinees for measurement of interest clusters at the professional level.

The COPS-P is recommended for use in college major selection and orientation, occupational selection and career changes. The results are keyed to college majors.

KEYED TO ABILITIES AND WORK VALUES - The COPS-P may be used with a measure of abilities, the Career Ability Placement Survey (CAPS) and a measure of values, the Career Orientation Placement and Evaluation Survey (COPEs).

KEYED TO COLLEGE MAJORS - Appropriate majors associated with each sub-cluster are listed on the Self-Interpretation Profile and Guide.

VALID OCCUPATIONAL STRUCTURE - The COPS-P is based on extensive factorial research into the structure of occupational interests represented in terms of eight major group clusters and the 16 COPS-P sub-clusters as described below.

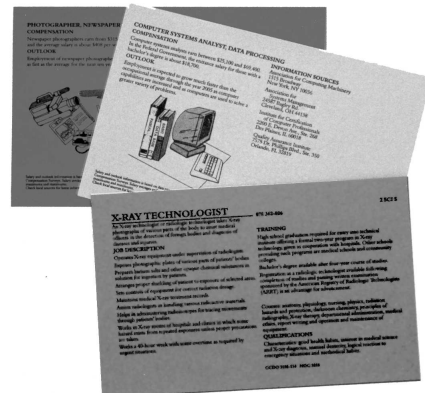
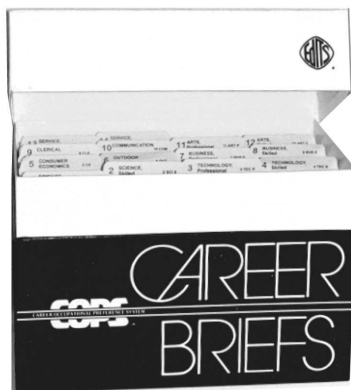

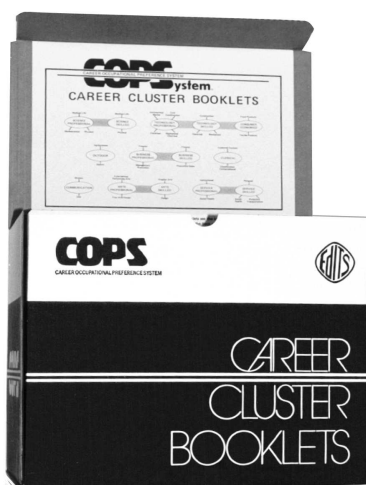

## The COPSsystem Career Briefs Kit

The COPSsystem *Career Briefs* is a kit of occupational description cards which answer the questions most asked by examinees about specific careers. Over 485 occupational cards, each color coded to its corresponding COPSsystem family cluster, are organized for easy reference. Each card contains a description of the occupation, training and qualifications required, salary, projected demand to the year 2005, sources of further information and they are keyed to the major sources of information including the DOT, OOH, and the NOC.

The COPSsystem *Career Cluster Booklets* present detailed and comprehensive descriptions of each of the Occupational Clusters.

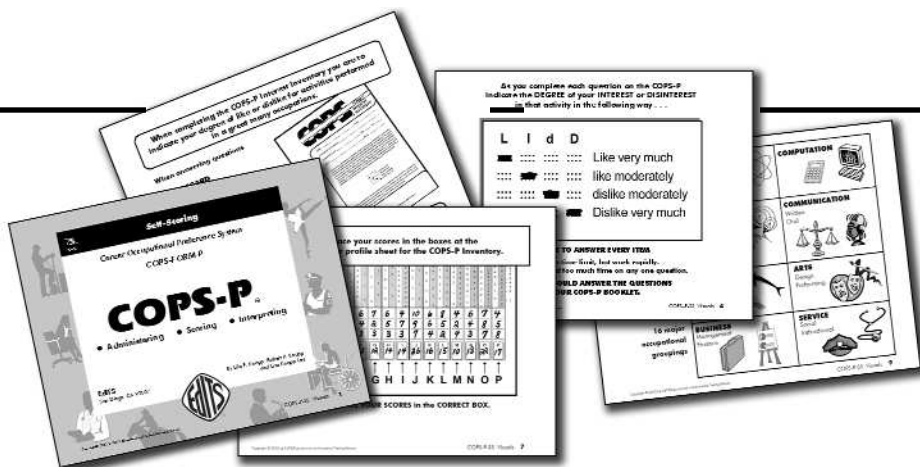
Based on the COPSsystem *Career Briefs Kit*, the *Occupational Outlook Handbook* (OOH), current Area Wage Survey Bulletins and the DOT, each of the *Cluster Booklets* presents jobs organized in terms of the clusters established in the COPSsystem.

Each of the *Cluster Booklets* introduces and describes a particular career cluster and its sub-clusters in-depth. Included in each booklet is a description of over 50 jobs, the training or job preparation requirements, ability and temperamental characteristics, a chart showing recent and projected proportion of persons employed in occupations of each cluster, a chart of courses to take in order to pursue a selected occupation, salary range and references from current sources. Index cards list from 100 to 200 additional job titles in each cluster.

Both the *Cluster Booklets* and the *Career Briefs Kit* contain the OOH year 2005 projections.

## COPS-P Visuals

The COPS-P *Visuals* are sets of overhead transparency masters for use in orientation, administration and interpretation. These are particularly useful for group administration of the instruments. Available in paper or CD presentation.
